Use of wardens to reinforce neighbourhood security is increasingly valued. But there are many situations in which an electronic neighbourhood watch network will complement and enhance a warden scheme.

It is standard practice for wardens to follow predefined patrol routes which focus on their designated areas. Incidents which occur outside these areas where there is no warden presence cause concern to those at home or at work, as the public feel vulnerable.

Electronic neighbourhood watch networks that coincide with existing patrol routes can enhance efficiency of the wardens' operation. More importantly, they can promote confidence among members of the community in these outlying areas, and provide a solution for their concerns.
